Awards Criteria

Awards at Stanthorpe State High School are grouped into four categories.

- *Industry Awards (all students)*
- *Academic Awards (all students)*
- *Vocational Education and Training Awards (Year 11 & 12)*
- *Special Awards (Various specified year levels)*

INDUSTRY AWARD CRITERIA

Award	Criteria
Industry Merit	Industry Merit Awards are presented to students with an Effort Point Average of at least 4.
Industry Excellence	Industry Excellence Awards are presented to students with an Effort Point Average of at least 4.5.

ACADEMIC AWARD CRITERIA

Award	Criteria
Academic Merit	Academic Merit Awards are presented to students with a Grade Point Average of at least 4.
Academic Excellence	Academic Excellence awards are presented to students with a Grade Point Average of at least 4.5.

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VET) AWARDS

Award	Criteria
VET Merit	VET Merit awards are presented to students who are enrolled in 3 VET courses, have passing grades in all subjects and an Effort Point Average of at least 4.
VET Excellence	VET Excellence awards are presented to students who are enrolled in 3 VET courses, have passing grades in all subjects and an Effort Point Average of at least 4.5.

Definitions:

Effort Point Average: a score of 1-5, calculated by first converting effort data to numeric data, where Excellent = 5, Very Good = 4, Satisfactory = 3, Unsatisfactory = 2, Unacceptable = 1 then taking the average across Semester 1 and Term 3 reports.

Grade Point Average: a score of 1-5, calculated by first converting academic A-E data to numeric data (where A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, D = 2, E = 1) and taking the average across Semester 1 and Term 3 reports.

SPECIAL AWARDS

Award	Criteria
RSL True Legends Award	The RSL True Legends Award is awarded to a student in year 9. Students can apply by researching a fallen service person named on the Stanthorpe War Memorial and submitting a fully referenced research paper.
ADF Long Tan Award for Youth Leadership & Teamwork	The ADF Long Tan Award for Youth Leadership & Teamwork is awarded to a year 10 student who shows the qualities of leadership, teamwork, values, problem solving, resourcefulness, communication, cooperation and community involvement.
Finch Leadership Award	The Finch Leadership Award is presented to a year 12 student who leads by example, actively participates in school and community events and is enthusiastic and responsible. Students self-nominate for this award by providing a written response to a selection panel who are responsible for choosing the successful applicant.
Rotary Award for Outstanding Service	The Rotary Award for Outstanding Service is given to a year 12 student who is a role model, who makes a consistent effort with school work, and displays commitment and dedication. Students self-nominate for this award by providing a written response to a selection panel who are responsible for choosing the successful applicant.
Lions Award for Involvement in Community Affairs	The Lions Award for Involvement in Community Affairs is presented to a year 12 student willing to assist others at school and in the community and who puts a consistent effort into their schoolwork. Students self-nominate for this award by providing a written response to a selection panel who choose the successful applicant.

<p>Mayors All Rounder Award</p>	<p>The Mayors All Rounder Award is intended for a year 12 student who participates in a wide range of school activities, has excellent conduct and achieves academic success across a range of subjects. Students self-nominate for this award by providing a written response to a selection panel who choose the successful applicant.</p>
<p>Ampol All Rounder Award</p>	<p>The Ampol All Rounder Award is presented to a year 12 student who has exemplary conduct, achieves across a range of subjects and has a willingness do their best at all times and assist others. Students self-nominate for this award by providing a written response to a selection panel who choose the successful applicant.</p>
<p>ADF Long Tan Award for Youth Leadership & Teamwork</p>	<p>The ADF Long Tan Award for Youth Leadership & Teamwork is presented to a student who shows the qualities of leadership, teamwork, values, problem solving, resourcefulness, communication, cooperation and community involvement. Students self-nominate for this award by providing a written response to a selection panel who choose the successful applicant.</p>
<p>Principals Award</p>	<p>The Principals Award is presented to a year 12 student or students who uphold the school values at all times and consistently display high levels of effort and behaviour. The successful applicant is selected by the Principal.</p>
<p>Subject Awards</p>	<p>Subject Awards are presented to the student with the highest result in each subject. For General Subjects, an interim award is presented based on internal assessment only. In the following year, a final award is presented where the outcome changes according to external assessment data.</p>
<p>School Dux</p>	<p>School Dux is awarded in the following year during the Induction Ceremony to a student with the highest ATAR score.</p>
