	Point Average of at least 4.
Academic	Academic Excellence awards are presented to students with a Grade
Excellence	Point Average of at least 4.5.

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VET) AWARDS

VET Merit	VET Merit awards are presented to students who are enrolled in 3
	VET courses, have passing grades in all subjects and an Effort Point
	Average of at least 4.
VET Excellence	VET Excellence awards are presented to students who are enrolled
	in 3 VET courses, have passing grades in all subjects and an Effort
	Point Average of at least 4.5.

Definitions:

Effort Point Average: a score of 1-5, calculated by first converting effort data to numeric data, where Excellent = 5, Very Good = 4, Satisfactory = 3, Unsatisfactory = 2, Unacceptable = 1 then taking the average across Semester 1 and Term 3 reports.

Grade Point Average: a score of 1-5, calculated by first converting academic A-E data to numeric data (where A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, D = 2, E = 1) and taking the average across Semester 1 and Term 3 reports.
